Modern revelation trumps all other scripture anyway. We could have no Bible or BofM at all, and things would go on just fine. We don't follow the Bible, we don't follow the BofM, we follow the prophet."

So maybe now you will understand the answer to this puzzle, as least from one Mormon's viewpoint. Mormonism is man-centered and Christianity is Christcentered!

LOVED BUT UNCOMFORTABLE

I want the Mormon people I am sharing with to feel loved but uncomfortable! As a matter of fact, I want them to feel as uncomfortable as Hell so they won't go there. What do I mean by that? Many churches and

to Mormons that the LDS walk away from these witnessing encounters emboldened and really strongly believing that they are the real Christians and that the LDS Church is God's one and only true chuch on the face of the earth.

Then there are churches and Christian organizations that teach their people to be so aggressive when witnessing to Mormons that it turns off the LDS people from ever accepting the real God, the real Jesus and real Biblical salvation. We, as believers at ex-Mormons, believe we need to have a balance! That is, when we are sharing Christ with the Mormon people, we absolutely want them to feel loved or our witnessing efforts are in vain.

However, it is crucial that we speak the truth in love and are bold in our sharing real, Biblical Christianity with them. For example, if I am sharing with a Mormon on how the Bible teaches that there is only one true God from Isaiah chapters 43-46, along with numerous other places in the Bible, they will have a strong difference of opinion. That is completely fine! However, I will question the LDS person further on why the Book of Mormon in Alma chapter 11 teaches there is only one God, yet their additional Scripture Doctrine and Covenants 132:19-20 teaches there are many gods. I ask this question with a loving attitude and NOT with a tone of anger or sarcasm. This approach should help our Mormon friends we are witnessing to feel loved, but very uncomfortable. How can there be only one God existing yet many gods existing at the same time? That doesn't make sense! They can't have their cake and eat it, too!

When the apostle Paul was sharing Christ and confronting the Judiazers in the church in Galatia, he asked them a very pointed question, "Have I now become your enemy by telling you the truth?" Show love to the Mormons Christian organizations teach Christians to be so loving every single time you are witnessing to them or your best just to make them feel more comfortable!

When a Mormon begins to doubt their faith, they will feel very uncomfortable. That is good! However, you don't want them to stay uncomfortable and without hope the rest of their lives. Take that opportunity to share with them that the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords loves them desperately and died for them, not so they can become gods and goddesses in the afterlife, but so they can have an eternal relationship with the one and only true God of the Bible, the Lord Jesus Christ!

But don't let them walk away from your witnessing encounter just feeling loved and comfortable, for in that case, my friend, you did not share the real gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and your witnessing efforts are useless! They should feel loved but uncomfortable! That will prove that you have cared for them and their soul, yet you have given them something to think about in Mormonism that is troubling doctrinally.

Do not have them research every problem you can think of as that will turn them off and be overwhelming for both of you. Give them 2-3 problems of Mormonism that concern you and concerns God and make a plan to get back together with you in the near future so they can have time to research the problems you have raised.

Make sure that they always feel loved by Christ but uncomfortable in the LDS Church with works, Joseph Smith, the Book of Mormon, many gods and becoming gods and goddesses. It is at this point that you know without a doubt you have shared the truth, while at the same time shared the major concerns you have with the truthfulness of the Mormon church because eternal souls and destinies are at stake. Pray, share the Bible and the real Jesus and watch God, the Holy Spirit, do the work and change lives for all eternity!!!
